

**PUBLIC MEETING**  
**May 23, 2000**

Chairman Mike Griffith called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Commissioner Loendorf was present. Commissioner Murray was absent attending a national workforce development meeting in Reno, Nevada. Others attending all or a portion of the meeting included Ron Alles, Sharon Haugen, Tom Pouliot, K. Paul Stahl, Warren Morehouse, and Carole Byrnes.

Minutes. There were no minutes to approve.

Proposed Minor Subdivision, Summary Review, Fraser Addition, Lot 5 Minor. The applicant proposes to create two lots, each for one single-family dwelling. The proposal is generally located east of Blaine Drive, approximately 1/4 mile north of Barrett Road. Applicants, George and Sandy Countryman, have requested that this public hearing be postponed to June 6, 2000 until the full Commission can be present. Therefore, the public hearing will be moved to June 6, 2000.

Kessler Annexation. County School Superintendent, Warren Morehouse, presented the Order of Annexation of School District 2 into School District 1. The annexation was approved by the voters on May 2, 2000. This annexation will be effective July 1, 2000.

Budget Amendments. County School Superintendent, Warren Morehouse, reported on the budget amendment resolutions for the Wolf Creek Elementary School District 13 and Lincoln School District 38. The Wolf Creek School District has requested reserves in the amount of \$4,444 due to unanticipated expenditures. The Lincoln School District has extended their bus route by 11 miles to pick up five additional children in the Lincoln area and therefore requested an additional \$11,463.98 to amend this bus route. These amendments have been approved by OPI.
