

**PUBLIC MEETING**  
**March 5, 2002**

Commissioner Karolin Loendorf called the meeting to order at 9:00am. Commissioners Murray and Varone were absent. Others attending all or a portion of the meeting included Eric Griffin and Robyn Brown.

Opening of the North Valley Request for Qualifications. Commissioner Loendorf opened the requests for qualifications from engineering firms to perform analysis on the existing infrastructure and the needed infrastructure for the areas of: **McHugh area in the North Valley.** The area to be evaluated is generally one-quarter mile on the west side of McHugh Drive, east to Montana Avenue, from Custer Avenue north to Forestvale Road. **Fairgrounds/Dunbar area in the North Valley.** The area to be evaluated is generally bounded by Custer Avenue to the south, Horseshoe Bend Road to the west and north, and Green Meadow Drive to the east. **Sewell/Bel Air area in the North Valley.** The Bel Air area to be evaluated is generally bounded by Sorenson Road to the north, Interstate 15 to the east, Sierra Road to the south, and undeveloped lands to the west. The Sewell area to be evaluated is generally bounded by Ray Road to the north, North Montana Avenue to the east, Rosemary Road to the south, and undeveloped lands to the west.

RFQs were submitted by: Entranco of Helena, MT, Materials Testing & Inspection of Helena, MT, Morrison-Maierle, Inc. of Helena, MT, Stahly Engineering of Helena, MT, Anderson-Montgomery of Helena, MT.

Commissioner Loendorf passed the requests for qualifications to staff for recommendation at a future public hearing.
