

**SUBDIVISION MEETING**  
**May 15, 2003**

Chair Anita Varone called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. Commissioners Murray and Tinsley were present. Others attending all or a portion of the meeting included Ron Alles, Cheryl Green, Jerry Grebenc, and Carole Byrnes.

Pledge of Allegiance. Everyone recited the pledge.

Resolution Ordering a Refund of Taxes and Assessments Paid. Cheryl Green reported Harold and Dorothy Wilson request a refund in the amount of \$1,308.84. Staff recommends a refund in the amount of \$654.41 for the second half of the May 2002 taxes because the taxes are delinquent. Mr. Wilson also receives a property tax exemption due to his 100% disabled rating from the Department of Veteran Affairs.

Commissioner Tinsley moved to deny the request for refund in the amount of \$1,308.54, and instead refund the second half taxes paid as recommended by staff in the amount of \$654.41 and authorize the chair to sign. Commissioner Murray seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Resolution Ordering a Refund of Special Assessments Paid. Cheryl Green reported on the refund of WQPD special assessments to Boyd Andrew Community Services in the amount of \$495.00 due to an erroneous assessment of water fees used at the Boyd Andrew Pre-Release Center. Staff recommends approve of the refund. Commissioner Murray moved to approve the refund and authorize the chair to sign. Commissioner Tinsley seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Final Plat Approval for Final the Clark Minor Subdivision. Jerry Grebenc reported that the applicants have completed all of the conditions and all of the taxes have been paid. Staff recommends approval of the final plat. By consensus, the Commissioners agreed to sign the final plat after the public meeting.

Agreement with Montana State University Extension Service. Ron Alles reported the collaboration agreement with Montana State University Extension Service is for the Food Stamp Nutrition Education Program for the period October 1, 2003 through September 30, 2004. Commissioner Murray moved to approve the agreement and authorize the chair to sign. Commissioner Tinsley seconded the motion and carried unanimously.

Resolution of Intention to Create the Augusta Fire Service Area. (cont. from /9/03). Ron Alles reported there are not enough signatures and recommends this be tabled until Thursday, May 22, 2003.

Other business. The County Attorney advised the Commission to add "Public Comments" to each agenda.

There was no other business and the meeting adjourned at 10:30 a.m.
