

Request for Qualifications from Engineers for Landfill Operation Management

Lewis and Clark County is soliciting a Statement of Qualifications, hereafter referred to as 'Proposals', to hire a firm to provide on-call operational assistance for solid waste services. This will be a five-year contract for a Subtitle D landfill rule compliance assurance professional engineering firm, qualified in the field of solid waste engineering and permitting to provide general engineering services including, but not limited to, Subtitle D compliance assurance, permitting, site development planning, strategic planning, fill sequence planning, soil management planning, groundwater and leachate management, alternative final cap design, closure planning, post closure care, quality assurance services, waste diversion planning, the periodic evaluation of landfill performance such as compaction and waste to soil ratios, surveying and staking, access road construction, drainage issues, discharge permitting, Tier II Gas and Greenhouse Gas reporting, Title V reporting, and composting operations. The agreement and payment terms will be negotiated with the selected offeror.

The County will review the proposal according to criteria as stated in the full RFQ. Qualified firms will be ranked in order by a selection committee. Proposals that are deemed incomplete by the selection committee will not be processed.

Lewis and Clark County reserve the right to reject any and all responses deemed unqualified, unsatisfactory, inappropriate or incomplete. Proposals become the property of Lewis and Clark County. The County is not responsible for paying costs associated with preparing a proposal.
