- ✿ Other – Add any additional information which may be pertinent for a scholarship.

Please include:

- ✿ A letter of Recommendation – Recommendation cannot be from family members. Letter should be from someone familiar with your academic achievements.
- ✿ 4-H Record Book – Required.

Selection Procedure: Scholarships will be selected by a committee who will review the applications and record books. No family members of applicants will be part of the committee.
