STANDING ORDER

Pursuant to this Court's statutory authority over the conduct of proceedings before it under Mont. Code Ann. §§ 3-1-111 and 3-1-402, and this Court's inherent authority to control matters of trial administration in the interests of fairness and justice, *Schuff v. A.T. Klemens & Son*, 2000 MT 357, ¶ 35, 303 Mont. 274, 16 P.3d 1002, the Court enters the following order regarding remote appearances in all DC and DN cases in Departments Three and Four:

 Attorneys who reside or have their principal place of business within 30 miles of the Lewis and Clark County Courthouse may not appear for court hearings by Zoom or other remote audio or video means unless they file a motion as soon as reasonably practicable in advance of the hearing and obtain leave of Court. Motions shall comply with the Uniform District Court Rules and the local rules of this Court, including the requirements that the motion be accompanied with a proposed order and that opposing counsel be contacted for their position. Motions will only be granted for good cause shown.

2. Leave for attorneys to appear remotely for contested merits hearings and trials is disfavored and will only be granted upon a compelling showing of need.

3. In criminal cases, criminal defendants may not appear by Zoom or other remote means for trials, and they may not appear by Zoom or other remote means for change of plea hearings, pretrial conferences, or sentencing hearings except upon a prior written motion and leave of Court for good cause shown. Witnesses in criminal cases may only appear by Zoom or other remote means upon either written stipulation of the parties, signed by the Defendant, or a showing that remote appearance will not violate the statutory and constitutional requirements regarding face-to-face confrontation.
