Lots of things happening this month.

We did two cleaning group this month. As we have mentioned before we will be moving the end of March. We decided to get a head start and start packing and moving things. We asked the peers to help us with this.

We will be moving our goal date to be out of the location of 1531 National Ave is March 20th. We will be moving to 3067 N. Montana Ave which is Good Samaritan Thrift store. We have a temporary area in the

ware house we will be moving to while construction is going on in our permanent space. We will still be able to be doing everything we are doing now just in a smaller space. We will still be providing a shuttle from Gods Love and the Library to OP this will help with the distance we are from downtown. This move will be exciting for us because it is permanent and no worries of getting kicked out or not having a space to be.

We are struggling with putting on a WRAP group weekly. You have to have 2 certified staff to run this group and at the moment due to staff leaving we do not have that. The trainings are most the time out of town and we are already short staffed enough we can not afford to have a staff gone and be able to stay open. We are working on this with the people who run WRAP to see when we will be able to get people to this training.

We were working on hiring for front desk but put that on hold because of the move it did not make sense to hire someone in that time.

Our groups are super great! Lots of fantastic talks about recovery and addiction and struggles. Peers asked for Celebrate recovery and thankfully we have a few staff who can do that group and it has been great. We do that group one time a week. We also run 8 dimensions of wellness group as well as a recovery topic group and wellbriety. We are really looking for people in the community to come and run some groups for us. We feel the peers get tired of hearing us talk all the time.

We have had a great month with housing! We had 2 peers get housed and one that is almost there.

We also send one peer to treatment and are working on getting two more there.
