## THE PROCESS



The Court approves an individual the opportunity to participate in the PASS program



PASS Officer meets with participant, assess needs, and works to connect the participant with community resources



Participant meets with professionals in the community to address mental health and substance use



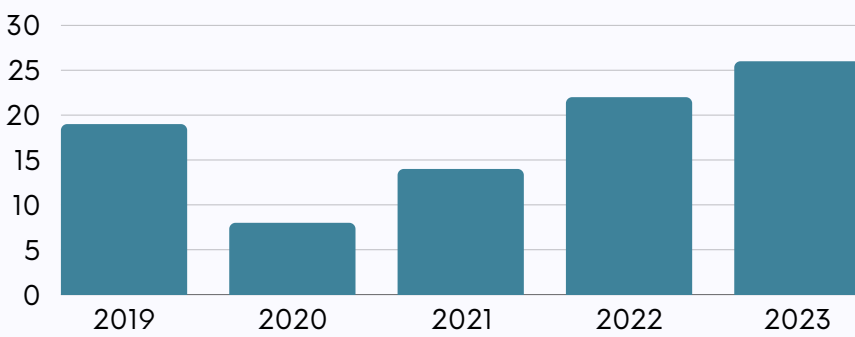
PASS Officer verifies completed appointments with mental health/substance use professionals

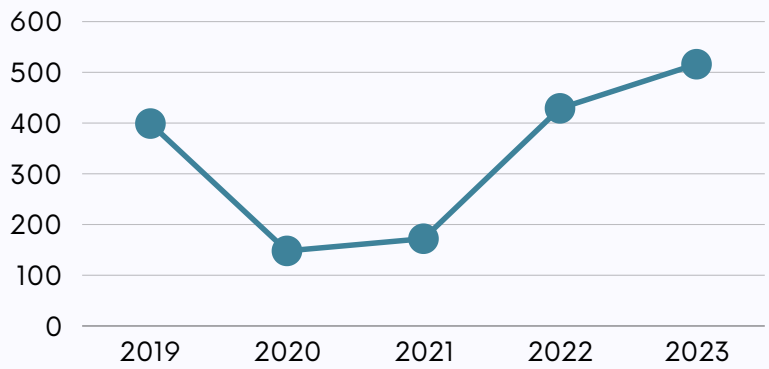

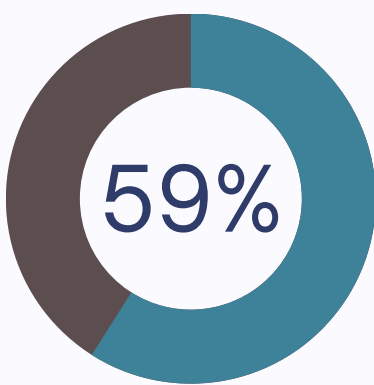

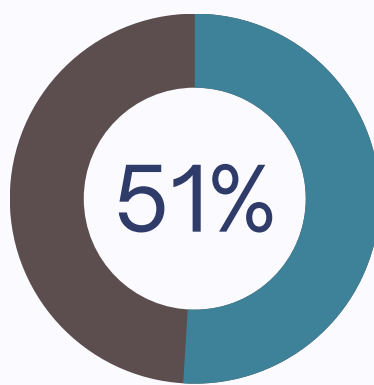


Most Common Services Discussed or Requested at Check-In

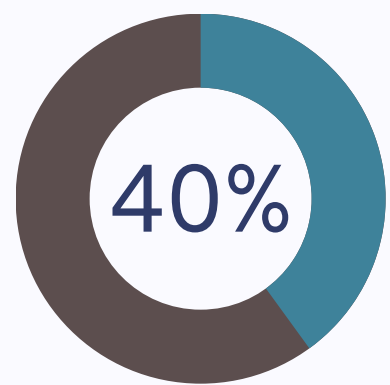
Mental Health Services



Substance Use Counseling or Treatment



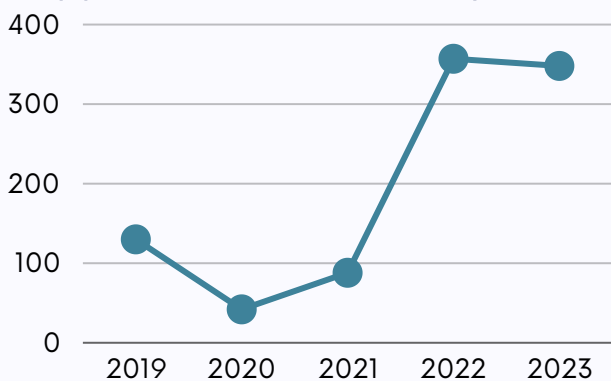

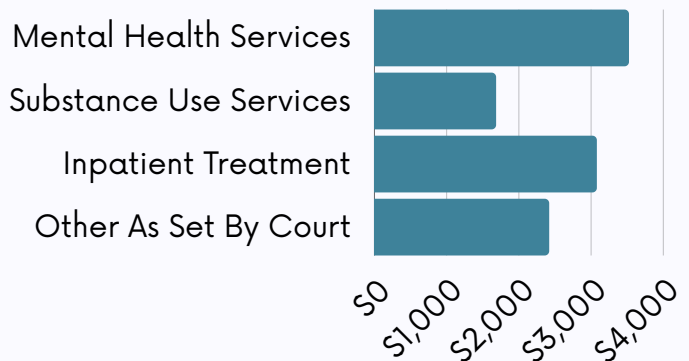
