The Lewis and Clark Board of County Commissioners Public Meeting was held on Tuesday, September 16, 2025 at 9:00 AM in Commission Chambers, Rm 330.

Roll Call

Consent Action Items

Fiscal Year 2026 Equitable Sharing Agreement and Certification. (Sherri Martin)

[8:06] Roger Baltz, Chief Administrative Officer, reported on consent action item 2a and recommended approval.

No public comment was received.

A motion to Approve was made by Commissioner Rolfe and seconded by Commissioner Hunthausen. The motion Passed on a 3- 0 vote.

Action Items

Grant Application to the Federal Emergency Management Agency Hazard Mitigation Program. (Dan Karlin)

[9:37] Dan Karlin, County Engineer, presented a grant application to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Hazard Mitigation Program for the Beartooth Road Erosion Mitigation Project in the amount of \$400,405.71 with a match of \$133,468.57. Staff recommends approval of the grant application.

No public comment was received.

A motion to Approve was made by Commissioner Hunthausen and seconded by Commissioner Rolfe. The motion Passed on a 3- 0 vote.

Amendment to the Cooperative Agreement Between Lewis and Clark Public Health and the United States Environmental Protection Agency. (Sarah Sandau)

[17:56] Sarah Sandau, Public Health Grants Specialist, presented an amendment to the agreement with the United States Environmental Protection Agency to increase the total amount by \$263,000 for the East Helena Lead Education and Assistance Program Institutional Controls. The budget period will remain the same. Staff recommends approval of the amendment.

No public comment was received.

A motion to Approve was made by Commissioner Rolfe and seconded by Commissioner Hunthausen. The motion Passed on a 3- 0 vote.

Contract Between Lewis and Clark County and Phat Trak Trail Company. (Planner: Angie Hubbard)

[22:44] Angie Hubbard, Planner II, presented a contract with Phat Trak Trail Company with funding from the Trail Stewardship Grant award for construction of Northstar Park trail not to exceed \$43,000. The performance period is through December 31, 2025. Staff recommends approval of the contract.

No public comment was received.

A motion to Approve was made by Commissioner Hunthausen and seconded by Commissioner Rolfe. The motion Passed on a 3- 0 vote.

Resolution 2025-104, Intent to Adopt a Schedule of Administrative Fees Beginning October 1, 2025 for the Lewis and Clark County Community Development and Planning Department and Public Works Department. (Planner: Greg McNally)

[27:32] Greg McNally, Planning Projects Manager, presented a resolution of intent to adopt a schedule for administrative fees for Lewis and Clark Community Development and Planning Department and the Public Works Department. Public comment will be accepted until 4pm September 29, 2025. A public hearing is scheduled for September 30, 2025. Staff recommends approval of the resolution.

No public comment was received.

A motion to Approve was made by Commissioner Hunthausen and seconded by Commissioner Rolfe. The motion Passed on a 3- 0 vote.

Agreement to Extend Preliminary Subdivision Approval for the Fasbender Minor Subdivision. (Applicant: Mike Fasbender) (Planner: Greg McNally)

[49:39] Greg McNally, Planning Projects Manager, presented a preliminary extension request for Fasbender Minor Subdivision to extend the conditional approval until March 22, 2026. Staff recommends approval of the extension.

No public comment was received.

A motion to Deny was made by Chair Payne and seconded by Commissioner Rolfe. The motion Failed on a 1-2 vote with Commissioners Hunthausen and Rolfe voting against.

Commissioner Rolfe made a motion to Approve the extension. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hunthausen. The motion Passed on a 2-1 vote with Commission Payne voting against.
