A RESOLUTION REQUESTING PROSECUTORIAL ASSISTANCE

WHEREAS, the Lewis and Clark County Attorney has requested prosecutorial assistance in the prosecution of State of Montana vs. Rusty Loomis; and,

WHEREAS, it is desired and deemed appropriate that special deputy county attorneys be appointed to assist in handling prosecution issues in the aforementioned case; and,

WHEREAS, Mont. Code Ann. § 2-15-501(5) authorizes the Attorney General for the State of Montana to provide assistance to county attorneys in the discharge of his duties; and,


WHEREAS, Dan Stusek and Mike Winsor are duly appointed Special Assistant Attorneys General for the State of Montana;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Special Assistant Attorneys General Dan Stusek and Mike Winsor are hereby appointed as special deputy county attorneys for Lewis and Clark County for the purpose of assisting in the prosecution of the aforementioned case.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the cost of prosecution services, travel, meals, lodging, secretarial assistance, investigative assistance and all other incidental expenses will be paid by the State of Montana. Expert witness fees and other costs of trial are the responsibility of Lewis and Clark County as would normally be the case if prosecution were being handled by the Lewis and Clark County Attorney.


