

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-18

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING ELECTION JUDGES FOR 2020-2022

WHEREAS, Section 13-4-101, MCA, requires the Board of County Commissioners to appoint three or more election judges for each precinct before the primary election in even-numbered years; and

WHEREAS, election judges are to be appointed from lists of qualified registered electors submitted by the county central committees of the political parties eligible to nominate candidates in the primary election; and

WHEREAS, the Lewis and Clark County Central Committees for the Democratic and Republican political parties did not submit such lists; and

WHEREAS, any person appointed as an election judge in even-numbered years must complete a training session before being eligible to serve as an election judge;

WHEREAS, April 2020 election judge training sessions were cancelled due to the coronavirus pandemic;

WHEREAS, additional judges for the November 3, 2020 election will be trained and appointed prior to the November 3, 2020 election; and

WHEREAS, training for June 2, 2020 Primary election judges will be conducted at the start of each election judge's shift;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners that Karyl Beattie, Betty Blankenship, Joan Bowsher, Wanda Cawley, Gale Evans, Bette J Hoven, Marsha Merrill, Lois O'Connor, Becky Piske, Eileen Rose, Susan Russell, Kim Sell, Janice Smith, Nick Smith, and Rita Tenneson are appointed election judges for the period from May 7, 2020 to May 31, 2022.
