

RESOLUTION 2022 - 33
REQUEST FOR PROSECUTORIAL ASSISTANCE

WHEREAS, the County Attorney requires general prosecutorial assistance in the prosecution of several cases, including State of Montana v. Leon Michael Ford, ADC-2020-493, pending in the Montana First Judicial District Court, Lewis and Clark County, to which former Deputy County Attorney and Assistant Attorney General Melissa Broch, who retired from state government effective March 31, 2022, was previously assigned while employed by both Lewis and Clark County and the Montana Attorney General's Office, and;

WHEREAS, the board of county commissioners may authorize the county attorney to obtain special counsel to assist in the prosecution of any criminal case pending in the county pursuant to Mont. Code Ann. § 7-4-205;

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED:

That Melissa Broch is hereby appointed as special deputy county attorney for Lewis and Clark County for the purpose of assisting in the prosecution of the aforementioned case.
