A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE MONTANA 250 COMMISSION FOR THE UNITED STATES SEMIQUINCENTENNIAL

RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be sent to the Lewis and Clark County legislative delegation and Montana 250 Commission.


