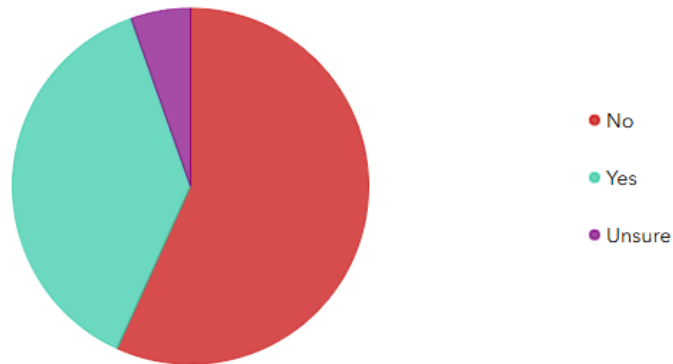

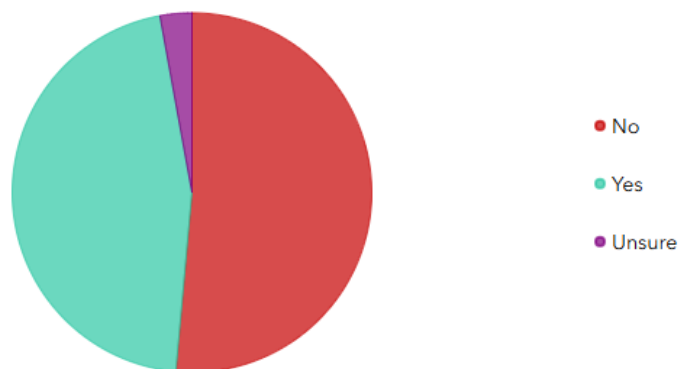

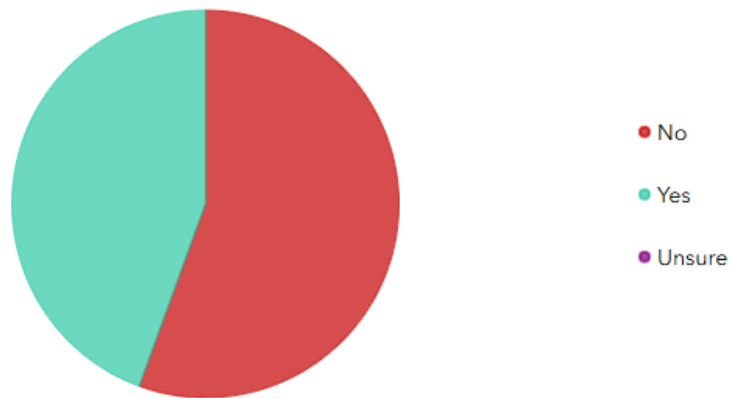

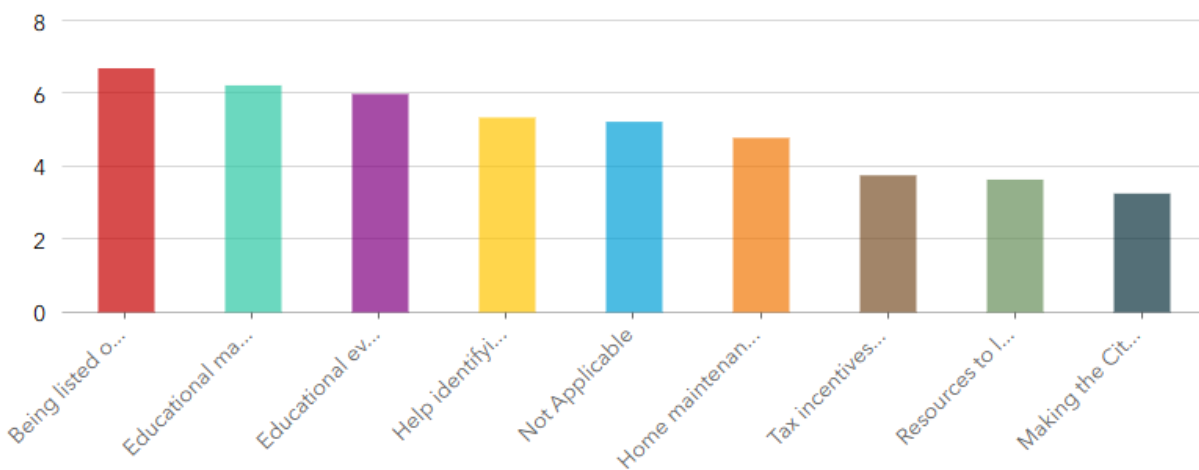

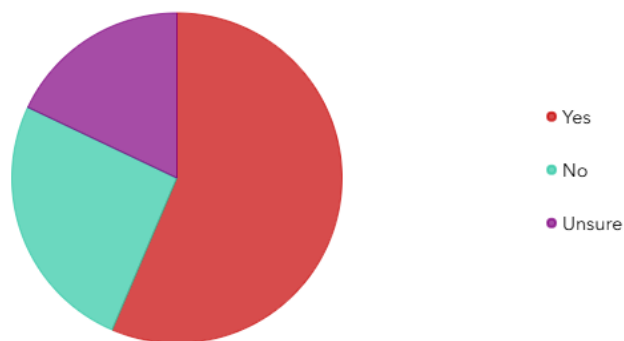

Column Bar Pie Map



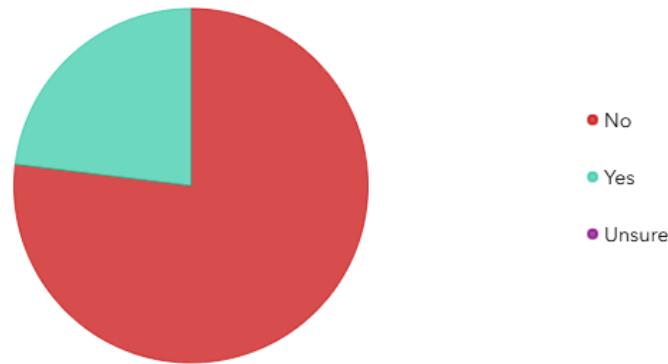

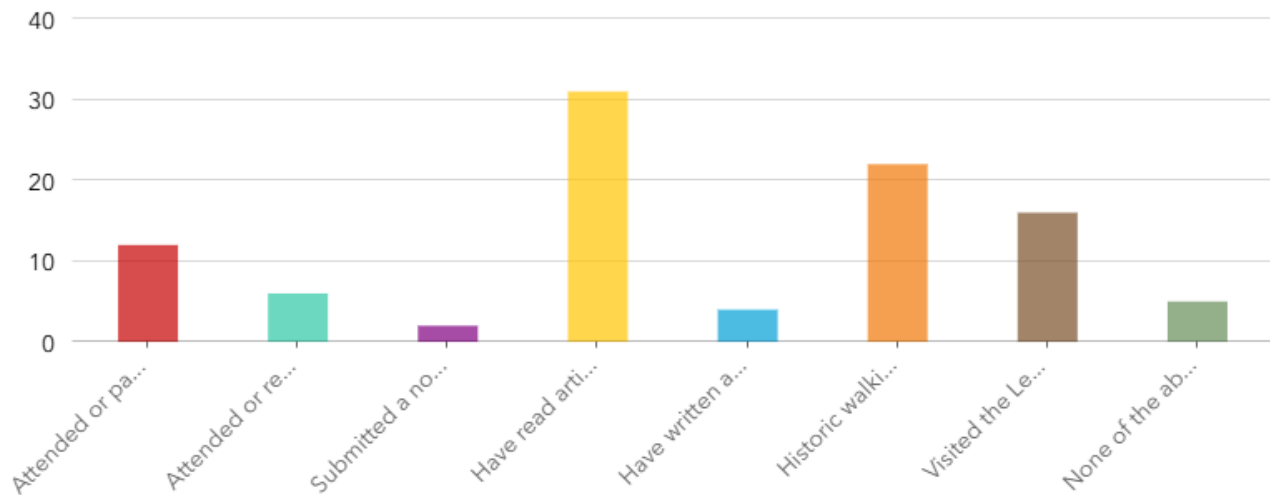

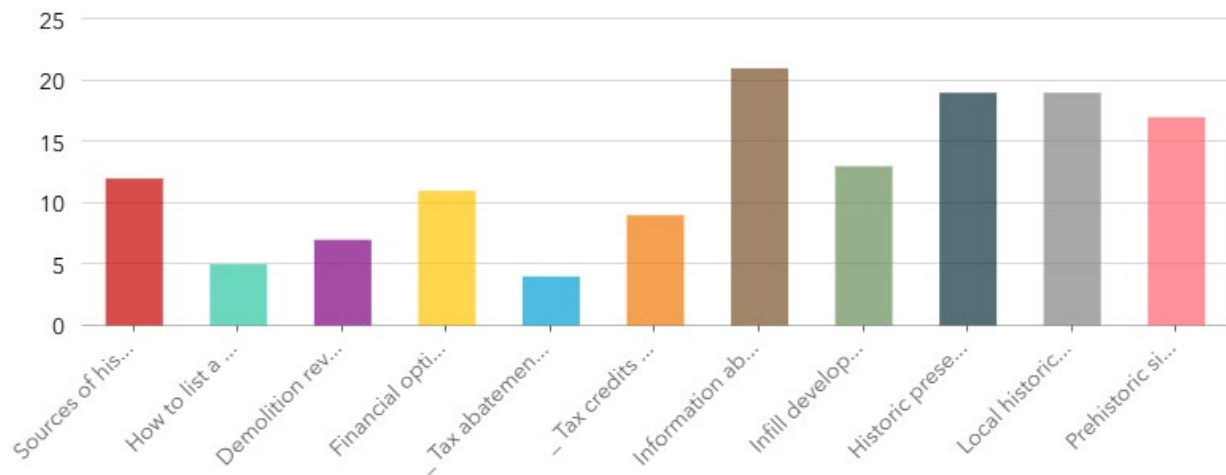
