To use landfill:

When entering the landfill, stop on the scale in front of the scale house. Open the scale house door and the glass scale door. Type in your account number, and select enter.

The Class IV landfill area is the first left once you are past the scale. You must unload as far back into the landfill cell as possible.

When leaving the landfill, stop on the scale in front of the scale house. Type in your account number and select enter which subtracts your empty weight. Keep copy of your weigh ticket for your records.

- You are dumping at your own risk. Lewis & Clark County and the landfill are not responsible for injuries to your drivers or damage to your vehicles.
- Payment on account: Landfill account holder understands that any unpaid balance delinquent over 30 days following the billing cycle will be considered past due. The account will be suspended for use and a \$25.00 reactivation fee will be added to the past due amount. Account must be paid in full to resume landfill privileges.
- Random load inspections will be conducted and video surveillance is in place to monitor all incoming loads.
 - Landfill account holder is responsible for all material contained within their load – no household/unauthorized material allowed. Violators will be charged a \$75.00 fee and \$50.00 per ton.
 - All loads must be covered or secured. If found in violation fees will apply.
