The 30th and 31st was spent finishing painting walls and unpacking. During this time Street outreach and OP staff made sure to make it to showers to keep all our clients updated as well as meal times at Gods

Love. We had hoped to be ready to open on April 1st, but as all things in life go we had a delay with permits and we were unable to open doors that day. We are hoping to be able to open on the April 6th.

In March we did a big clean up with HPD when they had to have people leave cruise ave. OP staff and clients were up there helping people pack up their belongings and make sure that they knew OP was open and could help them with any resources they needed. We assisted in cleaning up cruise ave. Clients that participated in the clean up were able to put their name on a list and if they had fines in City court they were able to get some of the fines knocked off. This is a great partnership we have with HPD, Parks and Rec and City Court!

We are looking forward to opening the doors in our new building!
